#### Dear Parents/Guardians:

As we look towards the 25/26 school year, we are sharing with you the Student Fees that could be required for your child.

Attached is a list of General Fees, Option costs, and Extra Curricular Activities that may be available for students to choose from. Please note Options and Extra Curricular Activities are for Junior High Students only.

The fees will be added to each student's Fee Sheet on SchoolZone in the fall.

Please know, we have done our best to determine the projected costs, they will be finalized in the fall. The fee should be the quoted amount, but will not exceed it. In the case that there is a small surplus at the end of the term, those dollars will be put towards the cost of a term end class treat.

In regards to Field Trips, please be aware that the cost of busing is shared between all students in that class, going on that trip - thus the fee can not be refunded in the case of a student's absence. If the vendor allows for refunds on specific admissions that are not used - we may be able to refund that portion.

Fees can be paid on SchoolZone using Visa, Mastercard, or the two step process of ETransfer. The office will also accept payment by Cash, Cheque, Visa, Mastercard or Debit.

Yellow Bus Pass	This fee is for students taking the yellow bus. Students can use this pass 4 times each month to use the ETS.	\$50 per month
ETS Bus Pass	ETS passes can be used 7 days a week.	\$60 per month
Combination Locks	Junior High students can purchase a lock in the office.	\$12 (not to exceed)
Lunch Supervision Fees	This is for students in Grades 4-6 who <u>do not</u> take the yellow bus. These fees cover the cost of the Lunch Supervisors we have hired.	\$14 (not to exceed)
Recorder	This is for students in Grades 4-6 who do not have a recorder and wish to purchase from the school.	\$14 (not to exceed)
Math Journal	This is for Gr 7-9 students who do not presently have one. Once purchased they can be used year to year.	\$11 (not to exceed)
Science Sketch Book	This is for Gr 7-9 students who do not presently have one.	\$17 (not to exceed)
AFA Artist Education	This is for all students for a school wide production.	\$30 (not to exceed)
Interactions Cooking Fee	This is for students in our Interactions classes only for classroom cooking.	\$25 (not to exceed)
